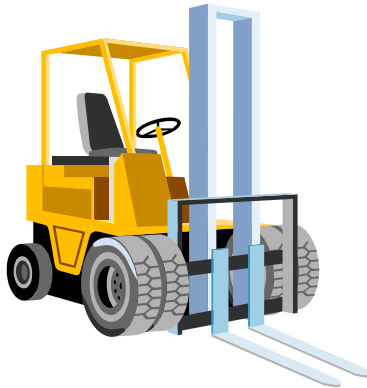

Actsafes Safety Passport 2016

Actsafes is the not-for profit association dedicated to the promotion of workplace health and safety in the Motion Picture and Performing Arts industries in British Columbia. Governed by the industry for the industry, our mandate includes providing industry related health & safety information, education, and training. When the industry perceives a need, Actsafes responds.

The Actsafes SAFETY PASSPORT is an online database intended to record and track worker training and certification. Through the Safety Passport, workers are able to record their training and track expiry dates. Their personal profile page can be printed and attached to their resume to list their training. Employers can access worker training information, review certifications online, exercising the due diligence required by WorkSafeBC and Federal law.

A variety of Actsafes PASSPORT courses are 100% reimbursable by IATSE Local 891. Courses completed are required to be submitted in the year taken to qualify for reimbursement. **The deadline for submission of 2015 course receipts is March 31, 2016.**

Effective May 21, 2015: Only active members in good standing who have worked a minimum of 30 days in the preceding three years (either on IATSE Local 891 signatory productions and/or by providing member services work for Local 891) qualify for training funds, unless they have been unable to meet the 30 day requirement as a result of absences due to disability, parental, political or educational leave. Members who have made themselves available to work through dispatch, but who have not received a call through dispatch, may access union training funds. This is based on a motion made and passed at the General Membership meeting on April 19, 2015.

The 30-day requirement does not apply to the following IATSE Local 891 courses, or safety related courses:

- Supervisory Course
- Shop Steward Course
- Anti-Harassment and Bullying
- OFA Level 1
- WHMIS
- BC Fed Occupational Health and Safety courses

Please refer to the chart below to determine if your departmentally-approved classification qualifies you for reimbursement or call 604-664-8940 for more detailed information.

Members book and pay for the course themselves. Upon successful completion, please submit the original receipt and confirmation of completion for reimbursement prior to the end of the year.
