You will see that the '*MySDS*' icon has successfully been added to you homepage. If you want to move it to a different location or page just press and hold on the icon and drag it to the spot that you wish. *Its that easy!*

Step 10

Inside the *Settings* menu you will want to scroll down. Under the 'Advanced' section press the option titled 'Privacy and *Security*'. In this page you will find the 'Username and passwords' option seen below.



Step 11

Within the 'Username and passwords' make sure that the check box 'Save sign-in info' is toggled on (Purple is on). Once you have this checked, sign into MySDS using your username and password. After pressing login, a popup like the one seen in **Step 5** should come up, choose the remember option. Now your browser will remember your login credentials!

Similarly, if you use the Google Chrome browser on your Android device. Go to the MySDS webpage and when you press the username or password box you will see a bar with a key on it tap the key and then select the 'Manage passwords' option.
